Global Findings

- 1. Screens are slow to load loading indicator appears often and slows down interaction. Could be a major usability burden when used by physicians in a fast-pasted environment (Must Fix)
- 2. Portrait mode not supported users expect iPad apps to function in both portrait & landscape orientations (Must Fix)
- 3. Inconsistent use of font styles & sizes should have rules and be consistent throughout. (Highly Recommended)
- **4. Accessibility of text/button labels** contrast ratios of text in many areas are below the minimum required contrast ratio. **(Must Fix)**












